



Marine Conservation Society Beach Clean-Up

To kick-start BAUK's sustainability involvement, five volunteering employees along with their families participated in a beach clean-up organised by the Marine Conservation Society at Donmouth Beach on December 3rd 2016.

Volunteers gathered at a car park located on the North side of the mouth of River Don, where a brief presentation was carried out by Marine Conservation Society staff member and head organizer, lain House.



The presentation outlined the importance of keeping our beaches clean, the various types of litter we might encounter on the beach and how to dispose of them correctly and safely. The volunteers were then given the correct equipment to pick up litter such as gloves, bin bags and litter pickers.

Following the presentation, volunteers made their way down to the beach where they spent the morning searching and collecting litter. After two hours of collecting litter, volunteers reconvened in the car park where lain collected the litter bags for proper disposal.

The event was an enriching experience which emphasized the importance of sustaining our local beaches and marine wildlife.
