Medical Care for the Terminally Ill

The Malaysian Association Help For The Poor Terminally Ill (PPPM) was established in 1997 by retired officials of the Kuala Lumpur General Hospital.

Their mission is to provide aid to terminally ill patients of Malaysian origin without bias to race, religion and creed. Provide training to members that are involved in volunteer work in the country. Setting up with approval of the relevant governing bodies, care centres and homes for terminally ill patients that are recommended by the government.

They also provide basic financial aid and support to members of the public that are in dire need of help. They instil awareness in road safety via lectures, seminars, talks and other knowledge sharing activities. They also provide financial support to deserving students.

As part of our sustainability plan for 2016, Bumi Armada Berhad has agreed to donate a total of RM100,000, which will be made in four payments towards this worthy cause. The first payment was delivered by the committee on 9 May 2016 at the NGO office in Jalan Gombak. Dato Dr. Faisal Abdullah, received the cheque on behalf of their organisation.

The contribution will be used to purchase equipment such as wheel chairs, provox - pulmonary and vocal rehabilitation for tracheostomy patients, artificial limbs and hearing aids.
