More than 130,000 people in the UK have Multiple sclerosis (MS), which is a neurological condition. MS is a condition that affects your brain and spinal cord. In MS, the coating that protects your nerves (myelin) is damaged. This causes a range of symptoms like blurred vision and problems with how we move think and feel.

Your immune system normally protects you by fighting off infection, however, in MS it attacks your nerves by mistake. Your nerves control lots of different parts of your body, that's why you can get MS symptoms in many parts of your body and it's also why everyone's MS is different.

Once diagnosed, MS stays for life, however treatments and specialists can help to manage the condition and its symptoms. There's no cure for MS yet - but MS Society is working on it, and they are there to help those affected.

Whether it's funding millions of pounds of MS research, being a kind voice at the end of the phone, helping people make sense of their diagnosis, giving grants to people who need them most, or campaigning against welfare cuts, MS Society couldn't make this difference without charitable donations.
